The Educational Addvocacy team have full knowlede and many years experience in working with Advisory Services within Local Education Authorities.

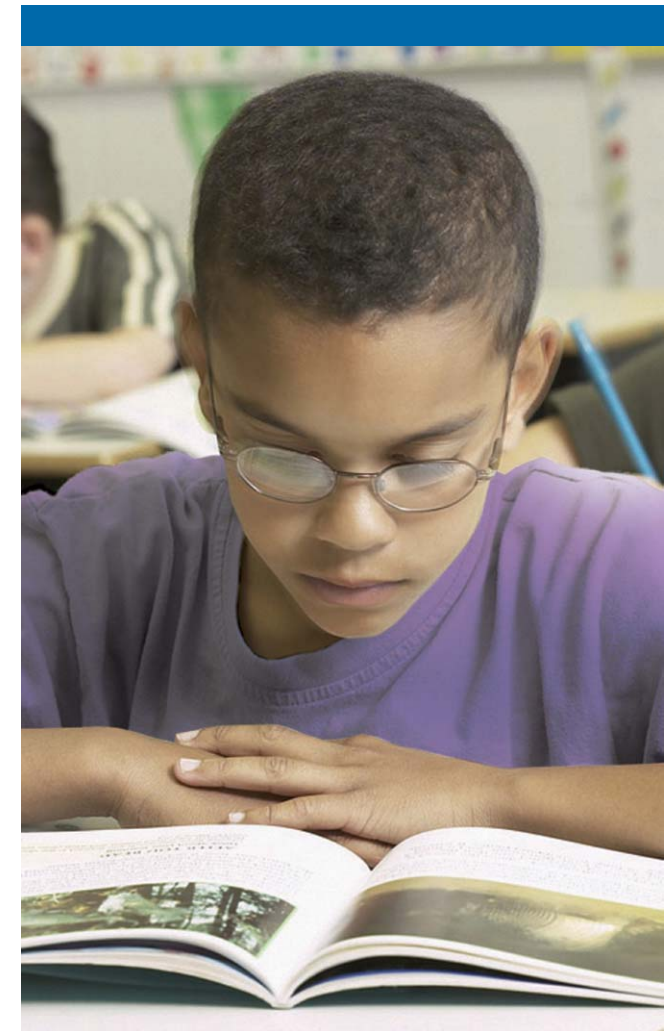
