Your child can be assessed in a place that is convenient to you; your child's school, your local Visual Impairment Service or at one of our resource centres in Birmingham,

Somerset or London. We can give you the opportunity to experience and access technology like Braille Devices, Screen Readers and Magnifiers.

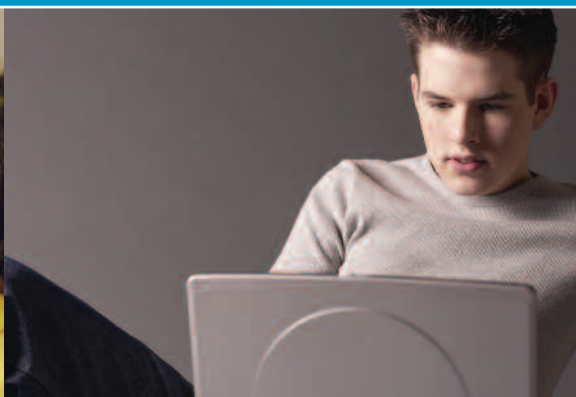
In addition to this, National Blind Children's Society run Information Technology Workshops where families and carers can try out equipment in a relaxed atmosphere.
