Is your child able to read the same books as their sighted peers?

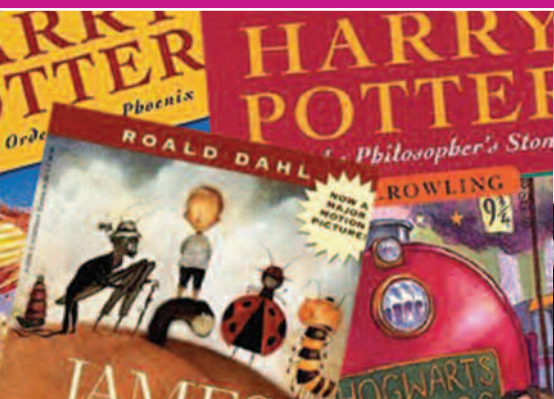
All children need books for fun, education, imagination and sharing! Children with a visual impairment have the same desire to read as their sighted peers. However, it is more difficult for them to find books that are suitable.

National Blind Children's Society produces books in large print for children who cannot see commercially available print.

We call this service CustomEyes because we tailor-make all of our books to suit the individual requirements of each child. If your child can see black writing on yellow paper at font size 24 then you can order your book to look like that.

You will receive a high quality version which will have the same cover as the original. We now have over 1,000 titles in our catalogue and are still expanding the list. We offer popular fiction and non-fiction titles for children of all ages.

We also support the National Curriculum with GCSE and A level English text plus revision guides for Key Stages 2, 3 and 4.
