The aim of National Blind Children's Society is to develop a programme of family weekends and activities throughout England giving families of children and young people with a visual impairment the chance to take a break and meet others in similar situations.

The activities are designed to be for the whole family including siblings and provide an opportunity to share experiences in a relaxed environment.

As experts in delivering services that meet the needs of children with visual impairments and their families, National Blind Children's Society is seen as the ideal

organisation to develop these activities and has the expertise to be able to provide a range of support and information services.

Children with a visual impairment will be offered a range of recreational opportunities to build their confidence, self esteem, to make new friends (both visually impaired and sighted) and counter any negative attitudes and barriers to their disability.

The children will be socially included with their new sighted friends, who will recognise them as a person rather than their disability.



These activities include family weekends, various activity days and a wonderful and memorable Christmas party. For those families who wish to take a family holiday in an environment which offers facilities for children who are visually impaired, a specially adapted mobile home is available for one week stays.
