Do you know what we can do for you?

**National Blind Children's Society supports children and young people who are visually impaired; their parents and carers. We offer support, information and advice from the time of diagnosis until the age of twenty-five.**

National Blind Children's Society offers five key services, with families often needing to access more than one of these services as the child's needs change and develop. All of our services are designed to improve lives and create opportunities. These key services are:

**Family Support and Information:**

Offers families with children with a visual impairment, emotional support, practical advice and timely, quality, up-to-date information, including Direction Point, a directory of services.

**Educational Advocacy:**

Offers independent, education advice and specialist support, helping children with a visual impairment to receive an appropriate education, which meets their needs.

**ICT and Sensory Equipment:**

Provides support, information and ICT assessments, to ensure that the child has access to the correct computer and communication equipment.



### **Recreational Activities:**

Offers family weekends, day activities and a mobile home, providing children with a visual impairment experiences and challenges to increase independence and life skills.

### **CustomEyes Books:**

Provides large print leisure and National Curriculum books, custom made to the specific font size and produced on coloured paper to meet the individual needs of the child.
