

Isle of Wedmore Golf Club

The Isle of Wedmore golf Club is situated overlooking the Somerset Levels on the outskirts of the historic village of Wedmore. The village dates back to Saxon times and features in history books as the location of the historic peace treaty made between King Alfred and the Danes in AD878, which is commemorated on the club emblem.

The name 'Isle of Wedmore' again can be tracked back to Saxon times when the village was completely surrounded by marshland and the Somerset Levels were flooded - something that is easy to imagine when looking over the Cheddar Valley from the back 9 holes over the past few winters!

The course features breathtaking panoramic views over the Mendip Hills, Cheddar Valley, Glastonbury Tor and the Somerset Levels from the gently undulating fairways. It has been carefully designed to maintain and enhance the existing environment, the many mature trees and hedgerows create a natural parkland setting.

The course is an 18 hole par 70 of just over 6000 yards, consisting of two nine hole loops both of which start and finish at the clubhouse. It will definitely provide a challenge for the experienced golfer with some tight driving holes and tricky par 3's, whilst also being gentle enough for the less skilful player.
